### Health and Safety Protocols Glossary

#### COVID-19 Testing

Tests designed to identify active infections of the SARS-CoV-2 virus, which causes COVID-19. There are two main types: PCR (Polymerase Chain Reaction) and Antigen tests.

PCR Test, Antigen Test, Rapid Test

#### Contact Tracing

The process of identifying, assessing, and managing individuals who have been exposed to a contagious disease to prevent further spread.

Case Investigation, Close Contact, Exposure Notification

#### Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Clothing, helmets, gloves, face shields, goggles, masks, and other equipment designed to minimize exposure to hazards that cause serious workplace injuries and illnesses.

Face Mask, Gloves, Hand Sanitizer, Social Distancing

#### Quarantine

The separation of individuals who were exposed to a contagious disease but have not developed symptoms, from others who have not been exposed, in order to prevent the spread of the disease.

Isolation, Self-Quarantine, Travel Quarantine

Travel Advisory

A warning issued by governments or international organizations regarding the safety and security conditions in a specific destination, often related to health risks, natural disasters, or political instability.

Level 1 - Exercise Normal Precautions, Level 2 - Exercise Increased Caution, Level 3 - Reconsider Travel, Level 4 - Do Not Travel

Vaccination

The process of introducing a vaccine into the body to stimulate the immune system to produce immunity to a specific disease, protecting the vaccinated person from subsequent infection.

Immunization, Vaccine Efficacy, Vaccine Side Effects, Herd Immunity

Workplace Health and Safety

The set of measures taken to ensure a safe and healthy working environment, preventing work-related injuries, illnesses, and deaths, and promoting overall employee well-being.

Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), Risk Assessment, Hazard Identification, Incident Reporting
